
FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

CORRECT FITTING OF R6526

Dismantling:

nut
retainer
rubber bushing

5. spring7. split collets8. retainer9. dirt shield10. retainer11. rubber bushing


12. spacer 13. sleeve

A oil transfer area B yellow label C coil support

- Set the vehicle on a car ramp;
- Unscrew nut 1 without causing the shock absorber rod to turn.
- Remove retainer 2 and rubber bushing 3.

For fitting instructions see FI027EU-B

- Replace nut 1 without tightening it.
- Remove bump stop 4
- Position tool 4068T and jaws 4082T on the spring
- Or the Facom compressor U79-J4 on spring 5.
- Position the vehicle with wheels off the ground.
- Compress spring 5.
- Remove ball-joint 6 from its seating.
- Remove the spring compressor.
- Unscrew nut 1 and remove the shock absorber assembly.

Re-assembly:

Position the following on the shock absorber body:

- Both split collets 7 keep them in place with an elastic band on their support C (new Monroe® part)
- · Lower spring seat 8
- Dirt shield 9
- Retainer 10
- Rubber cushion 11 (new Monroe® part)
- Spacer 12 and sleeve 13
- Spring 5

Fit the assembly in the upper mounting.

Caution: The shock absorber must be positioned with the oil transfer area A facing the ground and the yellow label B pointing towards the car body.

- Refit rubber cushion 3 (new Monroe® part), retainer 2.
- Replace nut 1 (new Monroe® part) without tightening it.
- Position the spring compressor.
- •Compress the spring in order to fit ball-joint 6 in its seal.
- •Remove the spring compressor.
- · Lower the vehicle to the ground.
- · Refit bump stop 4.
- Tighten screw 1 without causing the shock absorber rod to turn. Tightening torque: 1.75 daN.m.
